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NATIONALS FROM MEXICO AND THE UK RECOGNISED AS WINNERS OF CAMARADAS' ART COMPETITION 2014

 Winning art work 'Overdue Synchronicity' was exhibited at the Exhibition of <u>Modern</u> and Contemporary Latin Americana Art Show PINTA 2014.



London, England. 16 June, 2014. As a result of an unprecedented cultural <u>project</u> in the United Kingdom of Great Britain through which a Mexican artist and a British national successfully and jointly developed a project of original art, the artistic duo of Mexican Paula Zambrano and Briton Richard Hards took first place in the Camaradas Competition.

A total of nine projects of undoubted artistic quality were developed by pairs of participants and entered into the competition. After a carefully process of deliberation, the judges determined that the work the Mexican-British partnership of Zambrano-Hards, entitled Overdue Synchronicity, deserved first place. The work allowed a simultaneous projection and live broadcast of videos establishing a brief temporal connection between time zones in the official residence of the Government of Mexico in London, and the Experimental Museum El Eco in Mexico City, with support from curator Violeta Solis and Artist Julius Heinemann.

The work of Zambrano-Hards was displayed at The Modern and Contemporary Latin American Art Show, PINTA 2014. This cultural fair, which promotes contemporary art from Latin America, Spain and Portugal of took place between 12 and 15 June 2014 at Earls Court Exhibition Centre and highlighted the launch of the Mexican contemporary design exhibition De Ida y Vuelta, The Fair was curated by Mexican Ana Elena Mallet and coordinated by Manuel Diaz Cebrian.

PINTA also included ceramic pieces by Mexican designers Karla Sotres and Valentina González Wohlers, as well as products from Maggie Galton, who is known for working with artisans from indigenous communities, and a shawl designed by Herminio López Social METWORKS
